- The Lygon Arms Hotel, with roots dating from the 1300's, proudly stands on Broadway village High Street in the Cotswolds a designated area of outstanding natural beauty.
- Renowned names were drawn to the hotel for its historic prestige and The Lygon Arms boasts one of the world's most glamorous guest books. Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor stayed here in 1963 at the height of the scandal surrounding their affair.
- Under a 16th century barrel ceiling surrounded by wood panelling and two vast antler chandeliers is The Lygon Bar & Grill. Formerly a ballroom, today the room is a relaxed eating space complete with marble tabletops, oil paintings and a stone fireplace. The menu offers seasonal British fare celebrating local ingredients from sustainable suppliers.
- The Mediterranean-inspired Lygon Wine Bar focuses on delicious Italian and European wines by the glass, carafe and bottle. Guests can also enjoy a selection of Italian bites, pizzette and casual dishes.
- The traditional past time of taking Afternoon Tea is extremely popular and tea is served in the cosy Lygon Lounges and al fresco in the Courtyard, during warmer months. Head Chef also prepares themed afternoon teas throughout the year, including Easter, Mother's Day, Halloween, Christmas and in 2022 a special Royal Platinum Jubilee themed tea will be available in June.
- The Lygon Spa sits beside the three-acre private garden and facilities include a 13-metre indoor swimming pool with retractable roof, spa bath, Technogym equipment, male and female saunas, eucalyptus-scented steam room, single and double treatment rooms, Spa Kitchen and Bar, and a rooftop terrace, ideal for relaxation.
- Spa partners include British favourite OSKIA alongside Jessica Cosmetics in The Lygon Nail Studio. Facial treatments are from the leading luxury British skincare brand ELEMIS including their BIOTEC prescribed technology facials.
- Having undergone a multi-million-pound renovation, the 86 individually designed guest rooms combine old world glamour and modern luxury. The King Charles I Suite with its magnificent four poster bed and antiques was where Charles I and his supporters assembled. The spacious Courtyard Suites overlooking individual landscaped gardens are great for families and visitors with dogs, whilst Classic Rooms are complete with original paintings and Gordon Russell antique furniture.

- The Lygon Arms is an ideal choice for a Cotswolds family break with spacious rooms, seasonal children's menu and themed Afternoon Tea. During school holidays Kids Club is complimentary and offers Pizza Making and Cinema Screenings. Top attractions nearby include Broadway Tower, Snowhill Manor, Cotswold Wildlife Park and Bourton-on-the-Water Model Village.
- From tail-waggingly comfy dog beds, gardens to explore, and a muddy paws station, the Lygon Arms will become your dog's favourite place to visit. Dogs can be pampered by the Cotswolds grooming extraordinaire Lucie Ditchfield who collects your dog from the hotel and returns them fully groomed whilst you pop into the spa for a treatment or two.
- With open roaring fires, Cotswold stone buildings and surrounded by the beautiful countryside, the Lygon Arms makes a charming medieval wedding venue. Couples can opt for an intimate gathering in the room Oliver Cromwell stayed the night before the Battle of Worcester in 1651, to a larger exchange with up to 100 guests in the theatrical Edinburgh Room, or even exclusive hire of the whole property.
